

SAMPLE FILE - Australian Imports of Virgin Olive Oil

The purpose of this paper is to show what sort of analytical tables and charts are available in a standard TradeData Excel file for any product imported into Australia. The product chosen was **Virgin Olive Oil**. Similar information is available for any product. The information is supplied in Excel file format and the file is designed to enable efficient analysis of the underlying statistics. At the end of this paper three typical import transactions are listed to demonstrate the underlying import information that is available.

Table – Top Ten Origin Countries

The following table comes directly out of the standard excel file and shows – monthly – the top ten supply countries in terms of volumes as well as average prices per month. This table provides a convenient summary of month-to-month movements in imports. TradeData will normally supply the current year and five years of historic data. However, if more data is required, in most cases, we can supply at no extra charge.

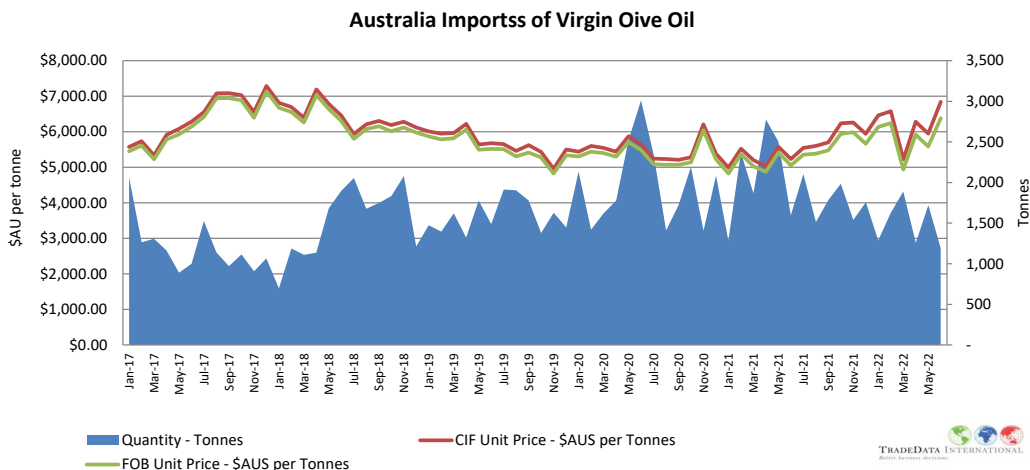
Details

There is a worksheet in the excel file that lists Port to Port details, by country, and average prices each month. Note these are prices at a Purchase Price (FOB) level, as well as a landed cost in Australia level (CIF) that include transport and insurance costs. A small sample is below.

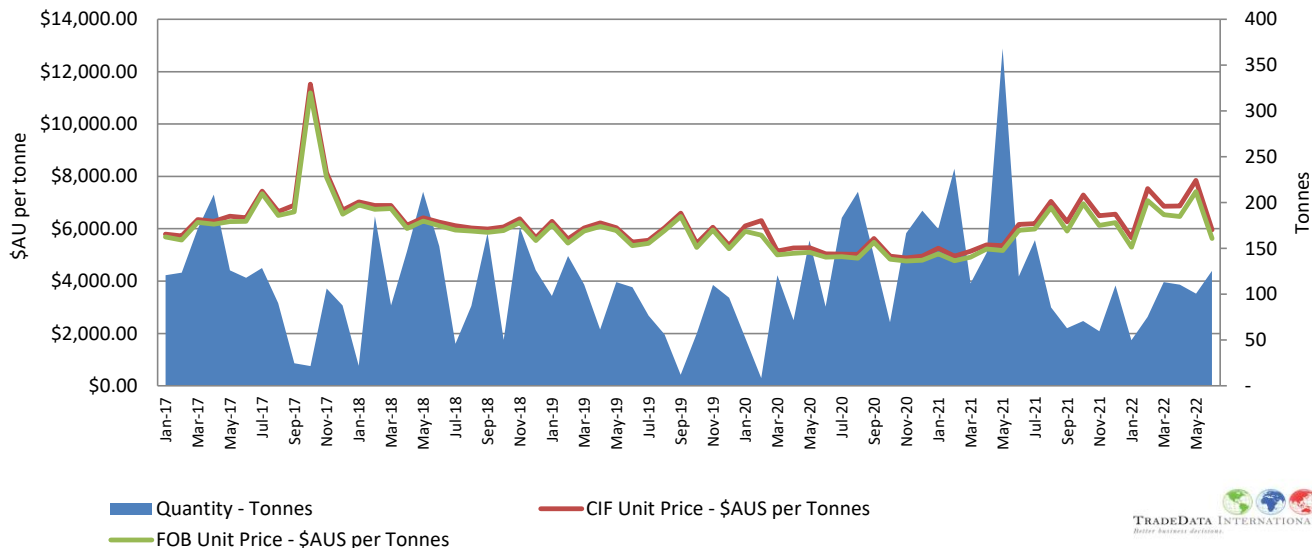
Price and Quantity

The next chart shows monthly movement in imports volumes - the blue shaded area of the chart - and in average prices. The green line shows average prices without Transport and Insurance Costs (FOB) and the Red Line includes Transport and Insurance cost (CIF). Between early 2018 to mid-2021 import volumes increased and are associated with declining average prices. Since then the reverse has occurred, average prices are increasing and this is associated with lower import volumes.



The excel file enables the user to select a supply country and then redraw this Price & Quantity chart only including imports from the selected country. The chart below lists Price and Quantity where imports only from Greece are selected. In contrast to total imports, imports from Greece are lower in the second half of each year and average prices are more stable. Imports in the second half of 2019 are well down on the previous year. Import volumes from Greece increased strongly in the first half of 2021 and only to fall away late in 2021. Import volumes are more muted thus far in 2022.

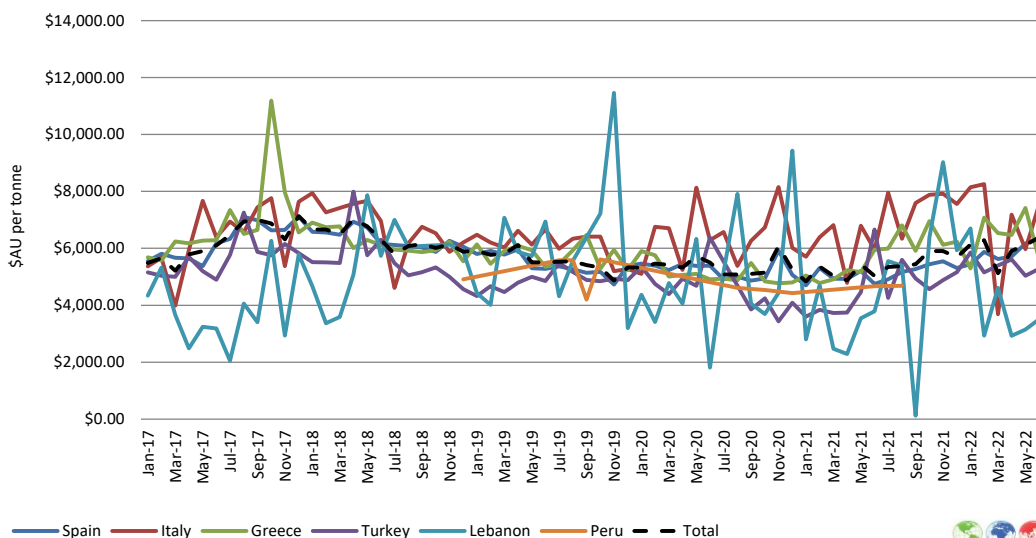
Australia Imports of Virgin Olive Oil



Average Prices – Top Six Supply Countries over Time

The following chart lists average prices for the top 6 supply countries to Australia. Most of the major supply countries supply at prices close to the overall average which in recent years has been below \$AU 6,000 per tonne. The exceptions are imports from Lebanon and China which are often sold at far lower prices. They are both relatively small suppliers to Australia. Average prices declined slowly over the last two years but have risen over the last 6 months.

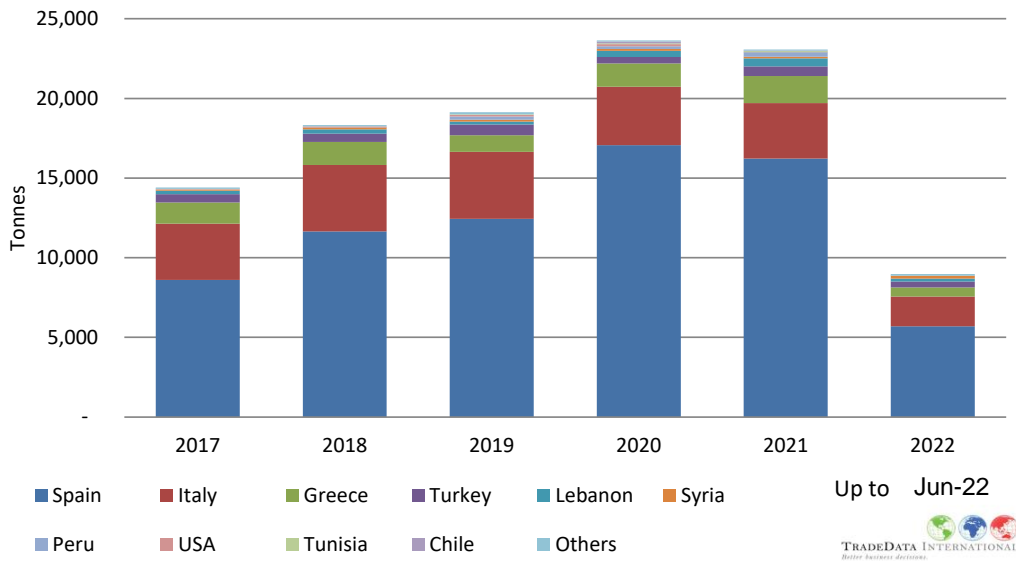
Average Prices - Top 6 Origin Countries - Virgin Olive Oil



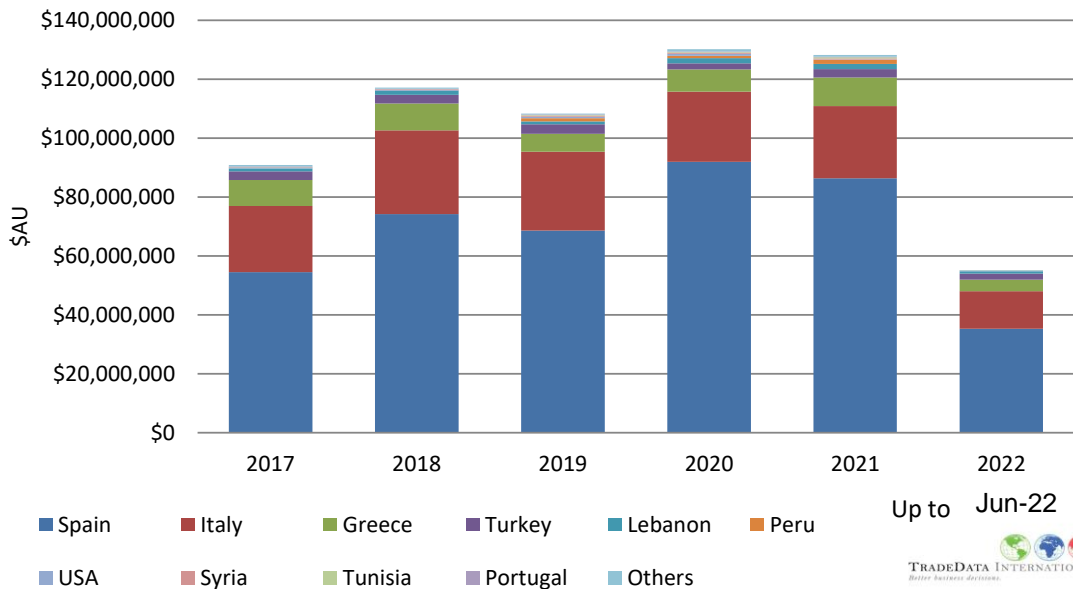
Major Supply Countries

The following two charts list annually the top ten supply countries to Australia, first in volume then in value terms. These charts draw the major supply countries market shares over time. Imports from Spain and to a lesser extent Italy dominate. The recent growth in import volumes is mostly sourced from Spain.

Australia Imports of Virgin Olive Oil by Quantity



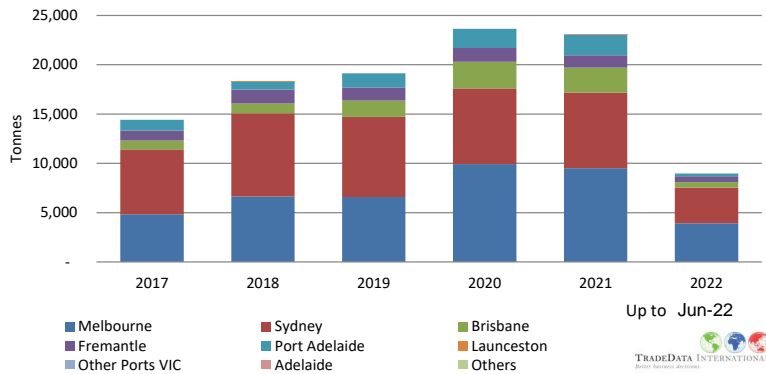
Australia Imports Virgin Olive Oil by Value



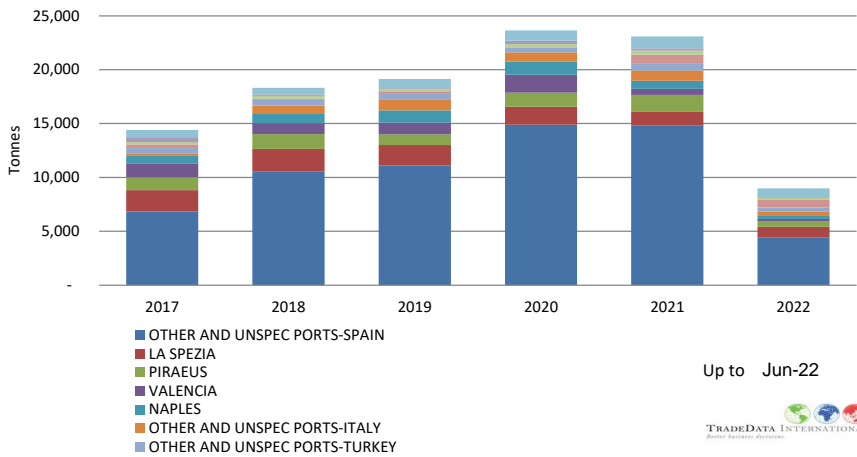
Imports Volumes by Ports of Loading and Discharge

Australia Imports of Virgin Olive Oil by Port of Discharge



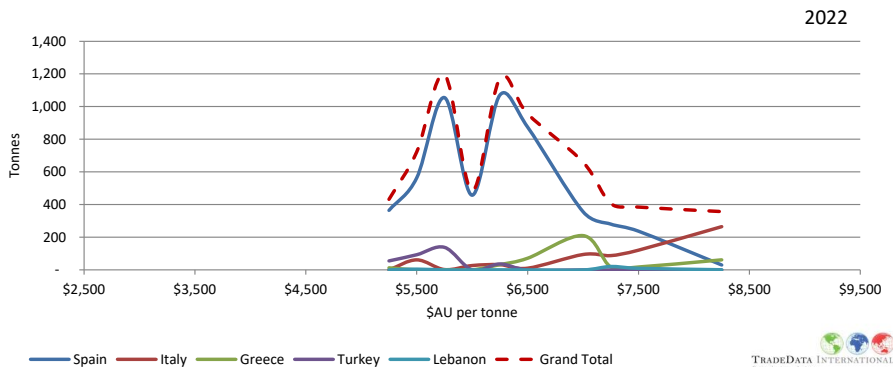
Australia Imports of Virgin Olive Oil by Overseas Ports of Loading



Market Segments

The following chart lists a Price Histogram by Country. This shows thus far in 2022, volumes imported at different price points, and which major supply country supplied at these price points. The Excel file enables the user to select different years and to the chart will redraw itself accordingly. Spain is the major supply country and in 2021 supplies at prices between \$AUD 5,500 and \$AUD 6,500 per tonne. Italy a smaller supply country, supplies across a wide range of prices mostly at prices above \$AUD 8,000 per tonne. The two price points from Spain probably reflect Extra Virgin and Virgin Olive oil respectively.
